Snow still covers the mountains.


New buds appear.


Wild cherry trees start to bloom.

The green gets darker and darker until it envelops the white forest.











Life in the white forest is a relaxing one, but there is never a break for the seasons of natural beauty.

The pale pinks of spring, the fiery reds of the fall—they'll pass by if you don't take note.











The blue sky, the blue water—

nurturing life in the white forest.















After the mountains lose their brocade of leaves, it only takes one night to be transformed into a white forest.
